Visitor Rules



Please deposit \$3 per vehicle

Non-member visitors are asked to place donations in our donation canisters located at the parking lot and trail head. Membership information can be found on our information boards, trail maps and website.



Groups of 10 or more

Must schedule their visit at least 24 hours in advance.



Commercial photography

Any *for-profit* services provided on this property require a permit from the director.



Pets must be leashed

Pets must remain leashed at all times throughout the property. Please remove all pet waste into the trail head trash bins.



No smoking

Smoking is prohibited on the property, including all trails and the parking area.



Alcohol is prohibited

Alcohol is prohibited on the property, except with a permit from the director.



No wheeled vehicles

The only wheeled vehicles allowed outside of the parking area are strollers and wheelchairs.



No hunting or collecting

Please leave all natural objects in their place, including fruit and fungi. Catch and release fishing is permitted.
